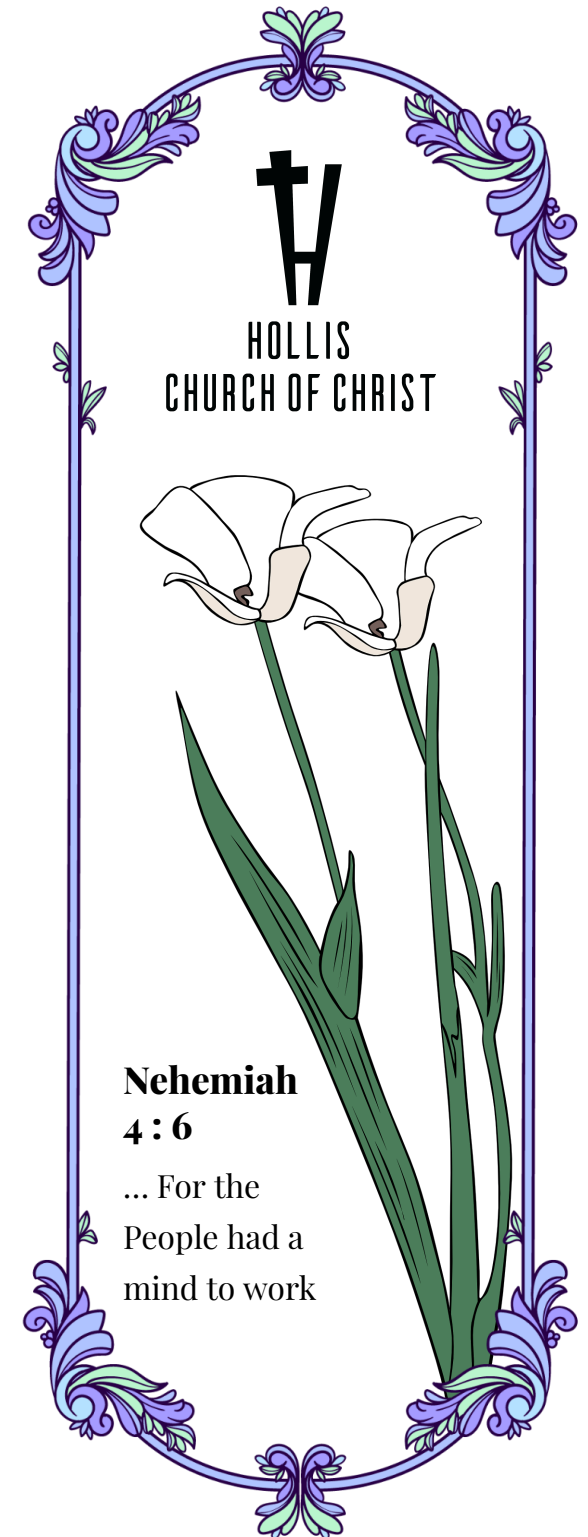

Title: Lord I Just Want to Say Thank You

MESSAGE



In ancient Israel leprosy was a powerful object lesson of the debilitating influence of sin in a person's life. Anyone suspected of having it had to go to a priest for examination (**Lev. 13:2-3**). He is unclean & shall live alone (**Lev. 13:45-46**). The leper was considered utterly unclean—physically and spiritually. **V14** Jesus looked at them and stared at them with the mindset of helping & understanding them. You cannot be a blessing to someone unless you know their situation. We must pray according to the needs that we see. The lepers were cured (blessed) as they obeyed & they gave Him an acknowledgment. Sometimes we take our blessings for granted & can't see them because we expect a blessing. **Luke 17:16 eucharisteó:** To give thanks, to be thankful. This term emphasizes a heart of gratitude & acknowledgment of God's grace & provision. In Jewish tradition, giving thanks to God was a central aspect of worship & daily life, reflected in prayers & psalms. The early Christians adopted & deepened this practice, emphasizing thanksgiving as a response to God's grace through Jesus Christ. It is thought, that grateful places more emphasis on appreciation toward others while thankful places the emphasis more on the relief felt by the person who was helped. **Deuteronomy**
